Being vegetarian can be a boon if one is eating right and a bane if one is not taking care of what one eats! There are vegetarians all over the world, but there is a remarkable difference between our vegetarians and vegetarians overseas.

People abroad mostly become vegetarians for philosophical and health reasons and therefore are careful that their diet is nutritionally adequate and healthful. Indians, being culturally vegetarian since generations, do not pay attention to their diet. Which is why, despite being vegetarian, they suffer from disorders associated with non-vegetarian diet.

An unbalanced non-veg diet is associated with heart disease, cholesterol problems, high blood pressure, cancer and obesity. A vegetarian diet is supposed to counter these maladies. But the paradox is that an unbalanced pure vegetarian diet can lead to exactly the same disorder. An unbalanced veg diet consists of fried food, lots of potatoes, dal with ghee, rice, deep fried veggies, lots of paneer and milk products. Similarly, an unbalanced non-veg diet consists of lots of non-veg food, very few vegetables and lots of butter, ghee and few fruits, if any.
