The police play an important role in safeguarding our freedom. Their duty is to prevent crime before it happens, or if it happens, to detect it and bring the offenders to justice. The police have a great responsibility and must always be careful. The police have greater powers than the private man. The powers of a private person are limited. He can arrest a man on suspicion of felony (a serious crime) but he has to prove later that felony has been actually committed. He should, also, handover the suspect to the police without any delay. But a police constable has greater powers. He can arrest a man on suspicion of felony, but he does not have to prove that felony has been actually committed. He can also take reasonable measures to investigate the matter before handing over the suspect to the police station. He can, for Example, put the suspect on an identification parade, take him to his house to see if he has any stolen goods there, and take him to the persons who can confirm or refute his alibi. The measures he takes must be reasonable. No one can complain against lawful arrests but if an arrest is unlawful, action can be taken against and damage claimed from the policeman.

A policeman, thus, has the authority to arrest a man who commits a crime; he also has the power to arrest a man who apparently commits a crime.
