Political freedom is possible only where justice is in the seat of authority, where all orders and degrees work in harmony with the organic laws which man neither made nor can alter- where the unwise are directed by the wise and those who are trusted with power, use it for the common good. A country so governed is a free country, be the form of the constitution what it may. A country not so governed is in bondage, be its 'suffrage never so universal. Where justice is supreme, no subject is forbidden anything which he has a right to' do or to desire and therefore it, that political change; revolutions, reforms, transfer of power from one order to another, from kings to aristocracies, from aristocracies to people are in themselves no necessary indications of political or moral advance. They mean nearly that those in authority are no longer fit to be trusted with exclusive power. They mean that those high persons are either ignorant and so incapable, or have forgotten the public good in their own pleasures, ambitions or superstition, that they have ceased to be the representatives of any superior wisdom or deeper moral insight and may therefore justly be deprived of privileges which they abuse for their own advantages and for public mischief.
