While there are several factors such as curriculum, pedagogy, teacher training and other that are preventing all children from achieving better learning outcomes, one factor that has disproportionately significant impact is the lack of a fair and equitable place at the starting line.

The ASER 2019 report found an absolute lack of school readiness among five year olds-only 23.5% of kids in government preschool could do a comprehension task, only 45% could do a puzzle, and only 36.8% could a task involving counting of objects.
