- Q.2 "IPRs are based on the protection of individual property rights and these are given as exclusive rights whereas traditional knowledge is held by individuals, tribes, nations and different independent communities and the use and sharing of this is guided and regulated by complex collective systems and customary laws and norms." Elaborate the IPR laws for protection of Traditional Knowledge.
