Q.1 a) A sells goods to B. B pays to A through a cheque. Before B could obtain the delivery of goods, his cheque has been dishonoured by the bank. A, therefore, refuses to give delivery of the goods until paid. Is A's action justified?

b) A and B, two chartered accountants, agree to carry on practice in common at the office of A under the name "A and B" for a period of seven years. The terms of agreement entered into between them provide that B should manage the office and supervise the clerical work and that he should draw a fixed allowance of ₹50,000 per month in lieu of profits. It is further agreed that losses, if any, shall be borne by A alone, and that after seven years A would be entitled to the office and all the other equipments, and B would not have any right, or claim, in respect of them. Are A and B partners?
